Part 1: English Proficiency (50 points) - Autograded

- a) **Spelling: 10 questions – 10 x 1 = 10 marks**
On the screen, for each question you will see a word spelled in 2 different ways; choose the correct spelling and drag it to the box.

- b) **Language: 20 questions – 10 x 1 = 20 marks**
Each question will have a sentence with a blank; click on the best answer to fill in the blank.

- c) **Paraphrasing: 10 questions – 10 x 1 = 10 marks**
Each question will display a short paragraph. Read it carefully then choose the answer that best paraphrases the paragraph.
Remember that paraphrasing means “expressing the meaning of the writer using different words or expression while preserving the meaning”

- d) **Punctuation: 10 questions – 10 x 1 = 10 marks**
Each question will display the same sentence written in 4 different ways. Read all sentences carefully and then choose the sentence where the punctuation rules are applied correctly.

Part 2: Reading Comprehension (50 points) - Autograded

a) Identifying The Main Idea: 10 questions – 2.5 x 10 = 25 marks

Each question will display a short paragraph. Read it carefully then choose the answer that best represents the main idea of the paragraph.

b) Reading comprehension 1 5 questions – 2 x 5 = 10 marks

You will be given a short text, less than 100-150 words, with 5 related questions. Read the text carefully and choose the right answer by clicking on it.

c) Reading comprehension 2 5 questions – 3 x 5 = 15 marks

You will be given a text, less than 400 words, with 5 related questions. Read the text carefully and choose the right answer by clicking on it.
